It seeks to enable social protection coverage to the most vulnerable groups, the ultrapoor population as right-based approaches.

The team seeks to assign a paid volunteer who will be regularly supporting to achieve the project and the organizational goals.

Brief Job Description

The volunteer will assist the Program Officer of SPCSN to implement the project activities. S/he is responsible to conduct/handling activities as mentioned below:

S/he will regularly support

- To maintain efficient administrative systems and control mechanisms to support the smooth running of the operations and ensure compliance with administrative, human resources, and financial rules and procedures.
- to writing meeting minutes in English and Nepali Languages.
- to may include drafting concept notes, event management, follow-up plan, and processing them to the executive board of SPCSN.
- to collect bill vouchers, library file management, and support program officer in maintaining the records and documentation.
- to support in financial settlement and procurement process of the organization.
- to prepare a financial report (Journal and voucher)
- to support any other tasks assigned by the SPCSN team.

10. Eligibility and Selection Criteria

• A candidate having at least BA, BBS, BSW, and or other relevant studies will be eligible to apply for the position.



- A candidate who knows NGO-based programs, social mobilization, data management, financial background (preferably NGO registration, internal/external audits, etc.), and relevant experience is preferred.
- A candidate having a two-wheeler vehicle and driving license is highly preferred.
- Shorlisted candidates will be notified through email and virtual interviews will be organized for selection processes.
- A selection committee member from SPCSN will be engaged during the selection processes.
- A preference will be given to female candidates.
